General Statement of Duties

BREATHE LA seeks to fill the position of a full-time Health Educator with Spanish language fluency.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Demonstrates a well-informed understanding of the programs and services that BREATHE LA provides to the community and a passion for serving minority and/or underserved populations
- Adheres to BREATHE LA's policies and procedures consistent with the mission, vision and value statements
- Conduct lung health and environmental education workshops
- Work with Registered Respiratory Therapist to conduct health risk assessments
- Develop health communication material, health education tutorials and health impact and summary content for social media
- Facilitate meetings with community partners to organize resources
- Deliver presentations at community events and local health fairs
- Cultivate and utilize community partnerships with like-minded groups, medical institutions, faith-based orgs to aid in recruitment of participants and fulfillment of program objectives
- Ability to summarize program outcome data effectively
